ENTRIES FLOWING IN

With the Regulations now being available for a number of weeks and both Round 1 of the ARC and WARC/Clubman being run, entries are now starting to flow in. **Competitors are reminded that Entries close this Thursday 25th March.**

With the successful running of the Trade Hire Donnelly Rally with 41 entries we can expect a similar local entry for the Quit Forest Rally. This would be an increase of 6 cars from 2009. Rumours have it that more than that number could enter as a number of crews were still getting their cars ready for

this year. Equally, we can expect and increase in entries for the ARC, with strong indication that we will have 17 starters, up from 14 last year.

On top of this we are expecting between 20 and 30 bikes & quads which will give a field of around 90 starters.

Quit Forest Rally Moto

Progress is being made on the Quit Forest Rally Moto and the Regulations will be out soon. The small crew (John & Andy) have been putting them together and were required to start from scratch. They have now got them into Motorcycling WA for approval. Hopefully, we can get them out into the market very soon.

Indications are that there will be between 20 & 30 bikes or quads entering. Entries will close on Monday 5th April

Cars, Bikes & Quads Running on Permits

A number of crews will be running vehicles that are not licensed for the road. An Unlicensed Vehicle Permit form must be filled out for all these vehicles and returned to the Department of Transport. It is very important that this form is submitted as early as possible to ensure the DoT have time to process it. The form is available on the QFR websites.



Nannup Service Park

We have had to make a few changes to the Nannup Service Park this year. The land behind the Catholic Church is no longer available. This will mean squeezing a few more WARC crews into the main street and other areas we can find. The Moto crews will be positioned at the bottom of the Bowling Green and the Clubman Crews at the back of the Hotel. Other areas available are in the car park across the road from the Shire in Adam Street and possibly behind the Shire and also next to and behind the Caltex (Ampol) Service Station.

A map will be issued with the available locations. We ask that all crews be patient when they arrive in Nannup as we find a spot suitable for their team. If you are joining up with other Teams, please make sure this is shown on the Entry Form.
