

ARTICLE 5 EVENT DESCRIPTION

- **A)** The Event will be a **SPRINT** event as defined in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- **B)** The Event consist of two heats over two days consisting of 4 sections. The Event will start on 6th April 2024 and will be approximately 550 km long, including 12 special stages totalling approximately 178 km.
- C) All special stages will be on gravel surfaces. See Itinerary Attachment 1.
- D) The NSWRC and ECCRS will be run as 3 heats and will run as follows. Points will be awarded for each heat.
 - Heat 1 Saturday: SS 1,2,3 = 51.22 km comp.
 - Heat 2 Saturday: SS 4,5,6 = 51.22 km comp.
 - Heat 3 Sunday SS 7,8,9 = 38.09 km comp.
- E) ACT Regional Rally series will be run as 1 heat over 2 days consisting of SS 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9 = 140.53km comp.

ARTICLE 6 EVENT ELIGIBILITY

As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations with the addition of:

- Motorsport Australia NSW Rally Championship NSW Rally Championship, East Coast Classic Rally Series –
 2WD, East Coast Classic Rally Series 4WD.
- ACT Regional Rally Series

ARTICLE 7 VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) For NSWRC, ECCRS and ACTRRS vehicle eligibility will be as per their respective 2024 Regulations

ARTICLE 8 COMPETITOR AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) All crews and automobiles will be eligible for NSW Championship and series points and awards.
- **C)** A compulsory crew briefing will be held at 1930hrs on Friday 5th April in the TBA.

ARTICLE 9 ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE & REFUND POLICY

- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available from the Motorsport Australia Members Portal https://portal.motorsport.org.au/octozy/login. Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is to be by 22nd March 2024, as directed on the entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.
- **B)** All entries **MUST** include a copy of all required documentation i.e. licences (Motorsport Australia and civil), automobile registration papers and club memberships.
- **C)** Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- **D)** Entries close at 1800hrs on Friday 23rd March 2024 for all crews.
- **E)** The number of entries will be limited to 60. If this limit is exceeded, preference will be given to higher seeded drivers and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry forms.
- F) The entry fees for the Event are fixed as follows:

•	Bosch Motorsport Australia Rally Championship	\$2495.00
•	NSW State Championship and ECCRS 2WD and 4WD	\$1950.00
•	ACT Regional Rally Series	\$1550.00

- **G)** Entries withdrawn after close of entry but prior to publication of the Entry List for the event will have their Entry Fee refunded less \$100 (Administration fee). Should the Competitor subsequently volunteer as an Official of the event this will be reduced to \$75, (or \$50 if the Competitor supplies additional Officials who also assist in the Event),
- **H)** Any entry withdrawn after the Entry List has been published and prior to 1st April 2024 may be refunded up to 30% of their entry fee. For withdrawals after this date there will be NO REFUND,
- I) If the Event is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition for reasons of Force Majeure, the Organisers may retain up to 25% of the Entry fee (as per NCR 11).

ARTICLE 10 INSURANCE

- **A)** Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia.
 - Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia National Insurance Program Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au
- B) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

ARTICLE 11 RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- A) The event will start from TC 0 located Service Park Exit EPIC at 0800 hrs on 6th April 2024,
- **B)** The starting system for the special stages will be in accordance with the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- C) The official time for the event shall be set to,
 - a. Saturday, and prior to the this, AEDT (Australian Eastern Daylight Time)
 - b. Sunday at 0200 AEST (Australian Eastern Standard Time).
 Note, Clocks go back 1hr at 0200 Sunday 7th April 2024.
- **D)** Competition in Heat 2 will only be available to an automobile:
 - Having finished the previous heat; or
 - Having started, but not necessarily finished, the previous heat and being placed in the overnight parc fermé, as detailed in the event itinerary.
- **E)** Any crew wishing to re-join in the next heat must advise the Competitor Relations Officer of the intention to restart no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled publication of the start list for the next heat.

ARTICLE 12 SCRUTINEERING

- **A)** Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutineering in accordance with the requirements of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Scrutineering, apparel checks, turbo sealing and automobile weighing for all automobiles will be held on Friday 5th April at Neal Bates Automotive, 48 Sheppard St Hume ACT, between 1200hrs and 1600hrs. A member of the service crew may present the automobile and apparel for inspection. A scrutineering schedule will be advised by Bulletin.
- **C)** All signage required by the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations must be in place for scrutineering, at which time, scrutineers will check the signage placement.
- **D)** Post event scrutineering will be advised by Bulletin.
- **E)** All Non-ARC crews are to be regionally scrutineered unless prior arrangement with the Clerk of the Course has been arranged.

ARTICLE 13 TESTING

- **A)** Testing will be available on Thursday 4th April There will be two 4 hr Sessions, one from 0730hrs to 1130hrs for ARC crews and the second from 1200hrs to 1600hrs. Testing costs are \$500 per car. Full details of the testing locations will be emailed direct to the crews.
- **B)** Applications for test sessions can be made using the online application form. No hard copy forms will be available.

ARTICLE 14 RECONNAISANCE

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- **B)** Reconnaissance will be monitored by the RallySafe Lite (RSLITE) app, including speed and number of passes through stages.
- C) The use of the RSLITE app is mandatory for all crews doing reconnaissance. Crews are reminded to have the latest version of RSLITE loaded to their phone.
- **D)** A reconnaissance schedule is shown at Attachment 2.

ARTICLE 16 SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Service Park will be in the grounds of EPIC and will be mainly "hard stand", there will be no power provided. Water and toilets are on site. The exact location is on the "burn out Pad" (access from Northbourne Ave at the Ampol service centre).
- C) The refuel is in close proximity to the service park, there will be remote refuels after SS1 and 4. These will be on a grass surface with limited space
- **D)** Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

ARTICLE 17 APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS – CONTROLS AND PARC FERMÉ

- A) For consistency, the penalties and other sporting regulations in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations shall apply to all crews entered in the Rally of Canberra (ARC), and any other associated events, with the exception of NSW state events and Act Regional Rally Series Time Control penalties, See 17 C) below.
- B) Power Stage Media Activities At the Power Stage Stop Point crews may be required to participate in media activities that will require the crew to remain in the Stop Point control area or close to it. The time that crews remain in this area will be deemed a neutralisation period. The crew will have a Stop Point official note the time of the neutralisation period on their Timecard, this time will be added to the Target Time for that Road Section.
- **C)** The NSW and ACT Championship regulations will apply to the results for the events as listed in Article 5 D) for penalties with respect to Time Controls.

ARTICLE 18 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RED FLAGS

Crews must make themselves familiar with these emergency procedures, as outlined in the Supplementary Regulations and in front of the road book. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.

A) Emergency Procedure

- I. In the case of an accident where urgent medical or fire attention is required, where possible the red "SOS" sign should be immediately displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. The Crew, if possible, where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) should press the "SOS" button, if available. The system will ask "Medical" or "Fire"? The Crew must press one of the buttons to confirm the situation which will advise Rally Command so the correct emergency service can be dispatched. This can be done at any time following an accident, even if the "OK" message has been activated. If possible, the Crew should call the Rally Command emergency number and advise of their status.
- II. Any crew which has, the RallySafe red SOS screen displayed, the red "SOS" sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has sustained an accident but is not displaying the green "OK" sign shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance.
 - a. All following cars shall also stop.
 - b. The first car on the scene shall remine to render assistance.
 - c. The second car at the scene, if necessary, shall proceed to inform the next SOS radio point.
 - d. Notwithstanding the above, any person with appropriate training should remain on the scene if the situation demands
 - e. Subsequent cars shall leave a clear route for emergency vehicles and proceed at a reduced speed, to a maximum of 60kp/h, until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers.
 - f. Crews affected by this procedure will be allocated a time according to Article 22 of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations

III. In the event of a car stopping on the stage or an accident where immediate medical or fire intervention is not required, the "OK" sign must be clearly and actively shown by a Crew member to at least the three following vehicles and to any helicopter attempting at assist. Where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) the Crew MUST press the "OK" button within 1 minute of the vehicle stopping, for any reason. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty

B) Red Flag

In the event of a special stage needing to be stopped, for any reason, SOS point officials will wave a red flag and the screen of the RallySafe console will turn red and show the message "RED FLAG". On seeing any of these indications the crew **MUST**:

- I. reduce speed to less than 80km/h for the remainder of the special stage; and
- II. Crews must immediately confirm receipt of the electronic red flag by pressing the "ACKNOWLEDGE" button.
- III. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

C) Interruption of a Special Stage (including Super Special Stages) – Notional Time

When a special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, the Clerk of the Course will allocate, to each affected crew, a time which is judged to be reasonable and fair. A corresponding notification will be published by the Clerk of the Course, however, no crew which is solely or jointly responsible for stopping a stage may benefit from this measure. RSR-Special Stage Rally Articles 5.4 (e), (f) and (g) re Piggyback events do not apply to this event, as ARC and State crews may cross enter in the various competitions.

ARTICLE 19 RESULTS AND PROTESTS

- A) Provisional results will be published on Sportity. These provisional results will become final 30 minutes after publication, subject to no protests being received, no issues are raised out of post event scrutineering and have been approved by the Stewards.
- B) Protests must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules.
- C) The events listed in Article 5 D) will be scored and results issued by ChrisSport Results Service.

ARTICLE 20 AWARDS

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The following awards may be presented:

NSW Rally Championship

Outright: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Categories: 1st 2WD

Classes within 2WD Category:

1st Occ – 1600cc (Pocket Rocket)

1st 1601cc - 2000cc

1st 2001cc and over

East Coast Classic Rally Series-2WD

Outright: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

East Coast Classic Rally Series-4WD

Outright: 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Techworkz Automotive ACT Regional Rally Series

Gold Cup: 1st, 2nd, 3rd, Driver and Co-driver

Should there be less than 3 entries in a class or category the organisers reserve the right to combine or not award for those classes or categories.

The Organisers reserve the right to add to these awards.


ARTICLE 21 ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- A) Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.
- **B)** Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- C) Consumption of alcohol in the Service Park or any section of the competition venue under the control of rally officials is forbidden until ALL competition is concluded each day.
