Article 8. Import of Vehicles and Spare Parts

National Laws / Customs Clearance

To temporarily import rally and support vehicles, parts, tyres and components into Australia without payment of Customs Import Duty and Sales Tax is either under an ATA Carnet or FIA / AIT Carnet de Passage en Douane.

ATA Carnets are issued by the Chamber of Commerce in the Exporting Country. An ATA Carnet will allow the bringing of Rally Vehicles etc. into Australia for up to twelve months. All items not re-exported within this period will be liable for Duty and Sales Tax.

Article 12. Reconnaissance

A two-pass reconnaissance for all APRC and ARC competitors has been scheduled for Thursday 25th November from 0730 – 1700 hrs.

A two-pass reconnaissance for all NSW competitors has been scheduled for Friday 26th November from 1130 – 1630 hrs

All competitors taking part in reconnaissance must register at the Rally Secretariat to get all the necessary documentation before starting their reconnaissance.

Vehicles used for reconnaissance must comply with Articles 35.1 and 25.2 of the 2021 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations. Supplementary Regulations will include further details.

The Reconnaissance Schedule will be included in Rally Guide 2 and published in a Bulletin.

Competitors are reminded that all roads will be open to the public during reconnaissance and so must observe all applicable road rules and, at all times, be aware of oncoming traffic.

Article 13. Scrutineering, Sealing & Marking

Compulsory Scrutiny for all Asia-Pacific Rally Championship competitors will be held on Thursday 25th November 2021 from 1530hrs at Southern Cross University Block S

Article 14. Shakedown

The APRC Shakedown will take place on the morning of Friday 26th November 2021. Further information will be available in the Supplementary Regulations and Rally Guide 2.

All Asia-Pacific Rally Championship-registered Competitors and selected other Competitors will be required to attend.

All competitors at the Shakedown must have all livery, numbers and signage in place on their vehicles and must have completed pre-event scrutiny.

Article 15. Start Procedure

Ceremonial Start activities will be held on Friday 26th November 2021 at CeX International Stadium Forecourt.

The Rally Start will be on the morning of Saturday 27th November at TC0 which will be located within the Service Park. A map showing the location of this control will be provided in the road book.

Article 16. Finish Procedure

Refer also to Article 66 of the 2021 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations.

The Rally will finish in the afternoon of Sunday 28th November 2021 at the Service Park.
