22nd October 2021	Advice 1	NSW State Government Requirements for the Monaro Stages Rally & ARC Monaro Sprint Rally Event

### NSW State Government Requirements for the Monaro Stages Rally & ARC Monaro Sprint Rally Event - 11th December 2021

The Kosciuszko Automotive Monaro Stages Rally, including the ARC component (The Event) is subject to any COVID-19 restrictions that the NSW Government have in place **for the Event**.

Motorsport Australia have determined the vaccination status of competitors is to be determined by the event.

To protect our competitors, support crews, event officials, volunteers and their families - The Event is mandating that all attendees at the Event must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19\*.

*\* Excluding medical exemptions - please provide this exemption proof to officials when requested.*

This is expected to commence from Monday 25th October.

- Community sport for **fully vaccinated ONLY** – Competition can occur for ONLY fully vaccinated attendees which includes competitors, support crews, officials, volunteers and their families.
- **All indoor premises** will operate at 1 person per 4 sqm.
- **All outdoor premises** will operate at 1 person per 2 sqm.
- Masks required for all indoor settings.
- Masks not required in outdoor settings.
- We ask that you carry a mask at all times.
- People under the age of 16 who are not fully vaccinated are allowed unaccompanied in all outdoor settings (Proof of age for Juniors will be required).

You will be required to check-in using the Event QR code.

Event officials will check each attending persons COVID-19 vaccination status on arrival. This will include all event officials, volunteers, competitors and their support crews.

Please ensure you have an offline copy of your COVID-19 Vaccination certificate available (or Medical Exemption document) . You may not have access to data on your mobile device at the event HQ.

You will receive an arm-band that you will be required to wear for the duration of The Event.

All states and territory residents must comply with their state/territory requirements.

Please be aware that the LCCC (Light Car Club of Canberra Inc) will be subject to fines for non-compliance and these are significant. Because of this, the club will be enforcing the NSW Government requirements. LCCC will be co-ordinating and checking that Covid Safe Check-ins are performed at the entrance to the Event Venue and that all competitors, crews and attendees have undertaken vaccination. Please ensure that you ALL have proof of vaccination or medical exemption with you when attending the Event on 11th December.

**No Proof of Vaccination, No Entry (medical exemptions must have documents produced).**
