- **2022 NSW Clubman Rally Series Regulations**
- **2022 NSW Hyundai Rally Series Regulations**

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Motorsport Australia Safety 1st Integrity and Legal, Risk Management and Return to Race Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au

The organiser and promoter of the **2022 Coffs Coast Rally** to take place on 25th – 27th November 2022 will be Motorsport Australia.

Article 5 Event Eligibility

As per the ARC Sporting & Technical Regulations with the addition of:

- 2022 Motorsport Australia NSW State Championship
- 2022 East Coast Classic 2WD Rally Series
- 2022 East Coast Classic 4WD Rally Series
- 2022 NSW Clubman Rally Series
- 2022 NSW Hyundai Rally Series

Article 6 Event Description

- A) The Event will be an ENDURANCE format consisting of 7 Sections. The event will start on Saturday 26th November 2022 and finish on Sunday 27th November 2022 and will be approximately 738km long including 14 Special Stages with a competitive distance of 198.28km.
- B) The Event will be an ENDURANCE event as defined in the ARC Sporting Regulations and will consist of one heat over two days.
- C) The Motorsport Australia NSW Rally Championship, ECCRS 2WD and 4WD will be contested over 11 stages over 2 days. Raleigh SSS II (SS7), Newry II (SS8) and the final power stage Moleton II (SS14) will be for ARC entered competitors only.
- D) The NSW Clubman and NSW Hyundai Series will be contested over the first 6 stages without heats and points will be awarded based only on these Saturday results.
- E) The NSWRC, ECCRS-2WD and ECCRS4WD will be run as 2 heats as follows with points award for each heat:
- a. Heat 1 – Saturday: SS1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 = 94.60km competitive
 - b. Heat 2 – Sunday: SS9, 10, 11, 12, 13 = 79.81km competitive
- F) All NSW state competitors will need to book into TC8A (Flexi-service in) to have considered to have finished on Saturday.
- G) Invitational entries will run the same itinerary as the RSEA Motorsport Australia Rally Championship competitors

Article 7 Vehicle Eligibility

- A) As per the ARC Sporting & Technical Regulations.
- B) For NSW Rally Championship, East Coast Classic 2WD Rally Series, 4WD Rally Series, NSW Clubman Series and NSW Hyundai Series vehicle eligibility will be as per the 2022 NSW Rally Competition Conditions.
- C) A NSW RTA “UVP” will be valid for the event
- D) Invitation: Open to all competitors whose vehicle meets the specifications in the Motorsport Australia Regulations

Article 8 Competitor & Crew Eligibility

- A) As per the ARC Sporting & Technical Regulations.
- B) Crews who enter the NSW State Championship, East Coast Classic 2WD Rally Series or East Coast Classic 4WD Rally Series 2 day events will also be entitled to be awarded NSW Clubman Series or NSW Hyundai Series points, if eligible, based on their Saturday results only. To maintain this eligibility, these crews must run on roadbook only for the entire event and not participate in any reconnaissance. Crews entering the NSW State Championship, East Coast Classic 2WD Rally Series or East Coast Classic 4WD Rally Series must “opt in” by sending an email to the Event Secretary to receive these NSW Clubman/Hyundai Series points.

Article 9 Scrutiny

All crews (ARC and non-ARC) are to present a fully completed “Self-Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance” and “Self-Scrutiny Checklist” to the event secretary prior to the event. There will be Turbo sealing and vehicle weighing for all crews on Friday 25th November in the Service Park between 1200hrs and 1600hrs, a member of the service crew may present the vehicle for inspection. A full schedule will be issued prior to the event.

Article 10 Entry Form, Entries and Entry Fees

- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available through www.rally.com.au/coffscoast
Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is via EFT as directed on the entry form.
- B) Entries will only be accepted when the competitor, driver and co-driver have been nominated on the entry form and payment is made in full.
- C) All entries MUST include a copy of all the required documentation i.e. licences (Motorsport Australia and civil), registration papers and club memberships.
- D) Entries open upon the publication of these Supplementary Regulations
- E) Entries close Friday 11th November 2022 at 2000hrs for all crews
- F) Entries are limited to 60. If this is exceeded preference will be given to the higher seeded drivers and/or those who have competed in other ARC events in 2021 and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry form.
- G) The entry fee for the Event is fixed as follows. Please note that competitors that enter Saturday only can not change to both days once entries have closed.

Article 11 Testing

- A) Testing will be available on Thursday 24th November. There will one 4 hr sessions from 0700hrs to 1100 hrs and two test roads will be available during this time. The session costs \$500 per car. Full details of the locations will be emailed direct to the crew.
- B) Applications for Test sessions can be made when completing the On-Line Entry form. No hard copy forms will be available.

Article 12 Servicing and Refuelling

- A) A maximum of 10 service personnel per competing car starting the rally may provide service throughout the rally (any more than 2 service vehicles, requires an additional payment of \$250 per additional vehicle – Each service vehicle must be clearly identified by means of “Service” plates issued by the Organisers and affixed in the locations specified.

- B) Any service vehicles which do not fit within the allocated competitor service bay must be parked in the designated parking area at the northern end of the service park.
- C) Refuels will be located within the Service Park as well as a remote refuel on the Sunday, the remote refuel area will be restricted to 1 vehicle and 2 service crew. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements as per the ARC Sporting Regulations 18.3 (vii) and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.

D) **Flexi-Service**

For the operation of flexi-servicing, crews will enter the Flexi Service Holding Area/Parc Fermé.

Crews may then either enter the service park or leave their car in the Flexi Service Holding Area/Parc Fermé.

Should a car be unable to be driven under its own power from the Flexi Service Holding Area/Parc Fermé to the service area, the marshals and/or team personnel shall be permitted to push or tow the car to its dedicated service bay.

The competing car may be driven by an authorised representative of the competitor from the Flexi Service Holding Area/Parc Fermé to the service park and vice versa, respecting all the formalities of time card presentation and related penalties.

The competing car may be returned to the Flexi Service Holding Area/Parc Fermé before the allowed time has elapsed without penalty.

The operational window of flexi-servicing time is left to the discretion of the organiser but must be declared on the rally itinerary.

NOTE - In the Service Park Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.

The entire service park is a designated “Non-smoking” area.

Article 13 Reconnaissance

- A) As per the ARC Sporting & Technical Regulations, excepting that the speed limit is strictly 60km/h. Speeds will be monitored.
- B) It is NOT compulsory for NSWRC and ECCRS entered competitors to do reconnaissance as a “blind” roadbook will be provided on request. A full reconnaissance schedule will be provided in a bulletin.

For NSW Clubman and NSW Hyundai entered or eligible competitors, the use of pacenotes is banned for this Event and they will not participate in reconnaissance. Any NSW Clubman or NSW Hyundai crew found with pacenotes will be reported to the Stewards. The Stewards may impose a penalty up to and including disqualification from the Event. Pacenotes shall be considered as notes in any form, other than the official documents and maps issued or authorised by the Organisers.

C) **Use of RallySafe Recce Lite Phone Application**

The organisers of the Coffs Coast Rally will be using RallySafe Recce Lite phone application at this year’s event. As such it is mandatory for all competitors entered (who are performing recce) to download and use the application in accordance with the instructions in Appendix 4 – RS Lite Recce Information.

The purpose of the application is to allow the organisers to track competitors in the forest during recce, so we know where competitors are and to also allow for speeds to be tracked and enforced.

Any breach of Reconnaissance Rules will be referred to the Stewards for application of penalties.

The competitor invite codes will be published by 1700hrs Wednesday 23rd November via the Sportity Application as well as in a Bulletin.

Article 14 Running of the Rally

- A) The event will start from TC 0 located in the Service Park. A start list with each crew's start time will be published.
- B) After the first days final service all crews will be required to park their car in an overnight Parc Fermé except for NSW Clubman and NSW Hyundai entered competitors whose event will have finished.
- C) The Rally Start will be at **0730hrs** on 26th November 2022 from TC 0.
- D) Starting System for Special Stages will be as ARC Sporting Regulations, Part 1, Article 12.3
- E) The official time for the event shall be Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST)

Article 15 Controls and Parc Fermé

For consistency between those crews entered in the Coffs Coast Rally (ARC) and those in the NSWRC & other associated events the penalties and other sporting regulations in the ARC Rally Sporting Regulations shall apply to all events. Refer to ARC Sporting Regulations Appendix B

Article 16 Insurance

- A) Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au
- B) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the Rally. They are therefore not covered by the Insurance Policy of the Rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

Article 17 Shakedown

- A) There will not be a Shakedown Stage for the ARC or NSW components of this event.

Article 18 Results and Protests

- A) Provisional Results will be published Online on Sunday 27th November 2022 at 1800hrs. These results will become Final 30-minutes after posting subject to no protests being received.
- B) Protests must be lodged in accordance to the Motorsport Australia NCRs
- C) For NSW crews, please note that the official results and stage times will be posted on www.rally.com.au

Article 19 Awards

- A) For ARC Categories, as per the ARC Sporting & Technical Regulations.
- B) The following awards may be presented. NSWRC, ECCRS-2WD and ECCRS-4WD competitors must compete over both days to eligible for the event awards.

Article 20 Alcohol, Drugs, and other Substances

The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of any drug or other banned substance and subject to a penalty for a breach of the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.




Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any other Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day. The holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy at www.motorsport.org.au.




Article 21 COVID-19

Due to the ongoing and dynamic nature of the pandemic, COVID-19 requirements for all crews, officials and spectators will be posted closer to the event date and will be based on the published NSW Health Requirements at the time.

New RS Lite from RallySafe. The free app is available on the Google Play and Apple App store. Competitors are responsible for having a device capable of using the app with GPS tracking and a battery lasting the entirety of recce. Considerations should be made to make sure the phone or tablet can be charged and there are no 3rd party applications that may disable GPS tracking.

When you arrive and check in at the event, each car number will be given a unique code to enter into the app.



Main Screen when app is opened. Click "add event".



Enter unique code.



Click add event.



Click accept invite.



Click start tracking when beginning recce.



Main Screen off stage when tracking.

When logged into the event with your code, the main screen will display your current speed and two odometers. Both odometers can be reset by pressing and holding the mileage.

As you arrive to a stage, the screen will display the maximum KPH allowed, along with the odometers and your current speed. If you exceed the allowed speed limit, a red bar speeding message will be displayed at the top of the screen.



80kph is the speed limit.



Note the speeding message.

When you begin recce, the application must be active on your phone and stay active during transits and while on stages. The phone can be used for other uses such as texting, navigation, etc. but should stay on the RS Lite app as much as possible during transits and at all times on stages. Your position, speed, and direction of travel will be monitored during the recce period.

Additionally, if the app is forcefully disabled on stage, a report is generated and may result in an infraction being applied. With privacy concerns in mind, the app does not track or send data if it is not active on the screen. Because of this, competitors must make sure the app is active during recce. If the app doesn't report for an extended period of time during recce, an alert is sent in the monitoring system.
