ARTICLE 2 ORGANISATION

These Supplementary Regulations are to be read in conjunction with the Motorsport Australia Rally Championship (ARC) Sporting and Technical Regulations.

The number of the Motorsport Australia Permit authorising the event is: 823/2603/02

This Event is to be held under the FIA International Sporting Code, including Appendices, and the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, including Appendices.

The following Regulations are also applicable to this event:

- Motorsport Australia Tasmania Rally Championship (TRC) Regulations

This event will be conducted under, and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, including, but not limited to:

- Occupational Health and Safety Policy
- National Integrity Framework
- Diversity and Inclusion Policy
- Motorsport Australia Safety First Strategy

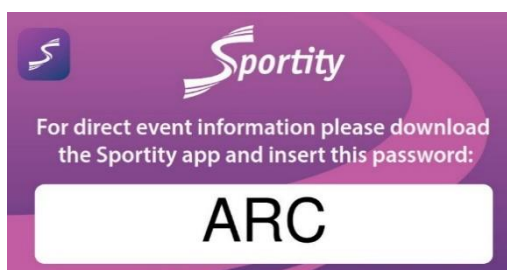

ARTICLE 5 EVENT ELIGIBILITY

As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations with the addition of:

- Motorsport Australia Tasmanian Rally Championship

ARTICLE 6 EVENT DESCRIPTION

- The ARC Event will be a **SPRINT** format consisting of 5 sections. The ARC event will start on 25th March 2023 and finish on Sunday 26th 2023 and will be approximately 680km long, including 12 special stages totalling approximately 204 km. All special stages will be on gravel surfaces. See ARC Itinerary - Appendix I.
- The ARC Event will be a **SPRINT** event as defined in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and will consist of two heats over two days.
- The TRC Event will be run on Saturday 25th March 2023. The TRC event will be approximately 330km long, including 6 special stages totalling approximately 120 km. All special stages will be on gravel surfaces. See TRC Itinerary - Appendix I.

ARTICLE 7 VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations
- Motorsport Australia Tasmania Rally Championship

ARTICLE 8 COMPETITOR AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) All crews and automobiles will be eligible for Motorsport Australia Tasmania Rally Championship points and awards.
- C) A crew briefing will be held at 16:00 on 24th March 2023 in the Rally HQ (Peppers Silo Hotel). This briefing is compulsory for both ARC and TRC, at least one member of each crew to attend.

ARTICLE 9 SCRUTINY

- A) Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutiny in accordance with the requirements of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations (Part 2 – Technical Regulations, Article 5) and the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations 2023 Addendum (Appendix 1 – 2023 Updates, Article 1(b)).
- B) ARC Scrutiny, apparel checks, turbo sealing and automobile weighing for all automobiles will be held on 24th March 2023 in the Buckby Motors between 10:00 and 15:00. A member of the service crew may present the automobile and apparel for inspection. A scrutiny schedule will be advised by Bulletin.
- C) All signage required by the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations must be in place for scrutiny, at which time, scrutineers will check the signage placement.
- D) ARC Post event scrutiny will be held at Buckby Motors Information regarding post event scrutiny, e.g. route to travel, will be advised by communication to affected teams.
- E) TRC Scrutiny can be conducted regionally.

ARTICLE 10 ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available from www.rally.com.au Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is to be made as directed on the entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the competitor, driver and co-driver have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.
- B) All entries **MUST** include a copy of all required documentation i.e. licences (Motorsport Australia and civil), automobile registration papers and club memberships.
- C) Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- D) Entries close at 1800hrs on 10th March 2023 for all crews.
- E) The number of entries will be limited to 60. If this limit is exceeded, preference will be given to higher seeded drivers and/or those who have competed in other ARC events in 2022, and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry forms.
- F) The entry fees for the Event are fixed as follows:
 - Motorsport Australia Rally Championship \$1750
 - Motorsport Australia Tasmania Rally Championship \$900

ARTICLE 11 TESTING

- A) Testing will be available to ARC Crews on Thursday 23rd March 2023 from 1100 hrs until 1500 hrs. Testing costs are \$500 per car. Full details of the testing locations will be emailed direct to the crews.
- B) Applications for test sessions can be made using the online application form. No hard copy forms will be available.

ARTICLE 12 SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The Service Park is in an open hard stand car park, Forester St, Invermay.
- C) No power or water is available so crews are encouraged to supply their own.
- D) A remote refuel will be located at Lebrina Hall, Lebrina. There is adequate space for parking a crew with a suitable surface.
- E) Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defuelling operation.

ARTICLE 13 RECONNAISSANCE

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Reconnaissance will be monitored by the RallySafe Lite (RSLITE) app, including speed and number of passes through stages.
- C) The use of the RSLITE app is mandatory for **ALL** crews doing reconnaissance, both ARC and TRC.
- D) A reconnaissance schedule for both ARC and TRC is shown in Appendix 2.

ARTICLE 14 RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- A) The event will start from TC 0 located at the Service Park
- B) The rally start will be at 0730hrs on Saturday 25th March 2023, from TC 0.
- C) The starting system for the special stages will be in accordance with the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- D) The official time for the event shall be set to Australian Eastern Daylight savings time.
- E) Competition in Heat 2 will only be available to an automobile:
 - i. Having finished the previous Heat; or
 - ii. Having started, but not necessarily finished, the previous Heat and being placed in the overnight parc fermé, as detailed in the event itinerary. Any crew wishing to re-join in the next Heat must contact the CRO prior to the scheduled publication of the start list for the next Heat.

ARTICLE 15 APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS – CONTROLS AND PARC FERMÉ

- A) For consistency, the penalties and other sporting regulations in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations, applicable to time controls and parc fermé, shall apply to crews entered in the Buckby Skoda Rally Launceston (ARC), those entered in the Motorsport Australia Tasmania Rally Championship and any other associated events.

ARTICLE 16 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RED FLAGS

- A) Crews must make themselves familiar with the emergency procedure outlined in the front of the roadbook. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards of the Meeting for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.
- B) Emergency Procedure
In the case of an accident where urgent medical attention is required, where possible, the red “SOS” sign should be immediately displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. Where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use, any manual “SOS” function should, if possible, be activated, in addition to any automatic process.

C) RallySafe Red Flag

RallySafe red flags will be used in all competing cars. When activated from rally control, the screen of the RallySafe console will turn red and show the message “RED FLAG.” Crews must immediately confirm receipt of the electronic red flag by pressing the “ACKNOWLEDGE” button and proceed as specified in Art. 21. (d) of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.

D) Meaning of a Red Flag

On passing a displayed red flag and/or receiving an electronic red flag, whichever happens first, the driver must immediately reduce speed, maintain this reduced speed until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers. Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

E) Interruption of a Special Stage (including Super Special Stages) – Notional Time

When a special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, the Clerk of the Course will allocate, to each affected crew, a time which is judged to be reasonable and fair. A corresponding notification will be published by the Clerk of the Course, however, no crew which is solely or jointly responsible for stopping a stage may benefit from this measure.

ARTICLE 17 INSURANCE

A) Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia.

Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia National Insurance Program Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au

B) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

ARTICLE 18 SHAKEDOWN

A) Shakedown will be held for ARC Crews on Thursday Morning at in the same location as the event testing. This is only for ARC registered.

ARTICLE 19 RESULTS AND PROTESTS

A) Provisional results will be published on Sportity. These results will become final 30 minutes after publication, subject to no protests being received.

B) Protests must be lodged in accordance to the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules.

ARTICLE 20 AWARDS

A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.

B) The TRC awards will be advised by bulletin.

ARTICLE 21 ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- A)** Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.



- B)** Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

- C)** Consumption of alcohol in the service park or any section of the competition venue under the control of rally officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day.
