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INTRODUCTION AND WELCOME

Fellow Rally “Tragics”,

Welcome to the 2025 Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland.

This year’s event is once again promoted by the Brisbane Sporting Car Club, with Accent Benchtops returning as naming rights sponsor. Thank you once again Glen, for your generosity and ongoing support. I also want to thank the ongoing support and hard work of Gympie Regional Council (who have returned as a major partner of the event), along with HQPlantations, who both provide us with some very challenging roads on which to compete. Not to mention the many friendly residents along the rally route.

ABRQ was excited and honoured to receive the 2024 *Mainfix* “Event of the Year” and the *Pedders Suspension & Brakes* “Rally Central of the Year” Awards, as voted by competitors for all ARC events nation-wide. The ABRQ Team will be working hard to maintain the standards achieved in 2024 and will be doing their darndest to again be considered for such awards in 2025.

Please be aware that Gympie “has a bit on” at the Showgrounds over the weekend of the rally. There will be four major events happening within the Showground precinct:

1. ABRQ (obviously),
2. a “Heritage Makers Fair” (Sat & Sun - est. attendance 4000+ people),
3. a 150+-car Cooloola Car Club vehicle display/Show-and-Shine (sponsored by Wishlist - Sat only), and
4. an Australian BBQ Alliance BBQ Championship competition (Fri night & Sat)

With this much activity in the one area I’m anticipating a very busy Rally Village and Service Park. Accommodation in the Gympie township and surrounding areas is filling fast so I suggest you don’t delay in booking yours.

Testing will be available on Thursday morning, with Recce for all crews on Thursday afternoon, which then continues on Friday. The amazingly popular “Wheels on Mary” street party will again be the Showcase activity on Friday evening.

This year’s Accent Benchtops Rally Qld will feature some 192 km of competitive stages. The event again uses HQP forest and Shire roads to the south and west of Gympie. Most of these roads were used in the 2024 event but with some subtle changes – most notably, a return to a forest area not used since the early IROQ days. With this change, crews will have 3 stages (run twice) on Saturday, with Sunday also having 3 stages (run twice), and which includes the ever-popular “Gympie Gold” Power Stage.

Alongside the ARC competition, the 2025 ABRQ event incorporates a round of the KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship, KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland 2WD Rally Championship, KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Junior Championship, Ackworth Recruitment Motorsport Australia Queensland Clubman Rally Series and WSC Subaru Experts Motorsport Australia Queensland Novice Rally Series. And something totally new to ABRQ for the 2025 event; a Rally Regularity competition, to help and encourage new and aspiring competitors entering our sport.

On behalf of the 2025 Accent Benchtops Rally Qld Team, I look forward to welcoming you and your Team to Gympie in July.

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ARTICLE 5 EVENT DESCRIPTION

- A) The Event will be a **SPRINT** event as defined in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The Event will consist of two heats over two days consisting of 4 sections, starting on Saturday 5th July 2025 and concluding on Sunday 6th July 2025. The Event will be approximately 457 km long, including 14 special stages totalling approximately 193 km of competitive distance (see Itinerary – Attachment 1a).
- C) The QLD Rally Championship **AND** QLD Clubman Series competition will commence on Saturday 5th July 2025 and will consist of 3 heats, concluding on Sunday 6th July 2025 (i.e. 2 days). The Event will be approximately 428 km in total, including 12 special stages totalling approximately 164 km of competitive distance (see Itinerary – Attachment 1b).
- D) The QLD Novice Series **AND** Regularity competition will commence on Saturday 5th July 2025 and consist of the four stages of Heat 1 (i.e. Section 1: Day 1). The Event will be approximately 126 km total with approximately 53 km of competitive distance (see Itinerary – Attachment 1b). Qld Novice competitors may opt to include Heat 2 and Heat 3 (no points scored) for additional cost (refer Article 9, item G).

All special stages have gravel surfaces, with 2 stages on Day 1 (Kandanga I & Kandanga II) each containing approx. 200m of bitumen surface, and 2 stages on Day 2 (Gympie Gold I & Gympie Gold II) each containing approx. 500m of bitumen surface.

ARTICLE 6 EVENT ELIGIBILITY

As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations with the addition of:

- The 2025 Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championships and Series Sporting Regulations
- The 2025-Motorsport Australia Rally-Regularity-Standing-Regulation

- A **Rally Regularity** Event will be run in conjunction with ABRQ. This will allow both new and existing Rally Competitors/Crew to participate in a Rally, with a focus on accuracy and navigation in a risk-controlled event format.

ARTICLE 7 VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The 2025 Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championships and Series Sporting Regulations
- C) **Rally Regularity:** The 2025-Motorsport Australia Rally-Regularity-Standing-Regulation

Rally Regularity: Refer to Item 4 (Automobile Requirements) of the Rally Regularity Standing Regulations.

ARTICLE 8 COMPETITOR AND CREW ELIGIBILITY

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Crews and automobiles who want to be eligible for Queensland Rally Championship points and awards will need to “opt-in” to the Queensland Rally Championship via the entry system.
- C) **Rally Regularity:** The 2025-Motorsport Australia Rally-Regularity-Standing-Regulation

Rally Regularity: Refer to Item 3 (Competitor & Crew Requirements) of the Rally Regularity Standing Regulations:
 - Drivers must possess current, valid civil driving licence.
 - Motorsport Australia Licence requirements for a Competitor, Driver, Co-Driver and Navigator refer to the Motorsport Australia Manual – General Appendix – Licences,

 - Speed Licence.
- D) A compulsory crew briefing will be held at 16:00hrs on Friday 4th July. The location will be advised in a Bulletin.

ARTICLE 9 ENTRY FORM, ENTRIES, ENTRY FEE & REFUND

- A) Entries are to be made via the online entry form available from the ARC Entry Portal:
<https://app.wolfacility.com/>
Competitors unable to access the online entry form are to contact the Event Secretary. Payment is to be by Credit Card or EFT, as directed on the entry form. Entries will only be accepted when the Competitor, Driver and Co-Driver/Navigator have been nominated on the entry form and payment has been made in full.
- B) All entries **MUST** include an electronic copy of all required documentation as listed in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations and/or as directed on the entry form.
- C) The Motorsport Australia Risk Warning, Disclaimer & Indemnity document, the Motorsport Australia Statement of Vehicle & Crew Compliance document, as well as any further documents required via the entry system must be acknowledged by the Competitor, Driver, Co-Driver/Navigator & Service Crew via the electronic requirements to the entry system.
- D) Entries open upon publication of these Supplementary Regulations.
- E) **Entries close on 20th June 2025 for all crews.**
- F) The number of entries may be limited to 70. If this limit is exceeded, preference will be given to ARC registered crews, then higher seeded drivers and/or those who have competed in other ARC events in 2025, and then in order of receipt of completed and paid entry forms.
- G) The entry fees for the Event are fixed as follows:

Each entry **MUST** include the Drivers name as a reference.

- I) Entries withdrawn after close of entry but prior to publication of the Entry List for the event will have their Entry Fee refunded less \$100 (Administration fee),
- J) Any entry withdrawn after the Entry List has been published and prior to 3 July 2025 may be refunded up to 30% of their entry fee. For withdrawals after this date there will be **NO REFUND**,
- K) If the Event is cancelled less than 48 hours prior to the scheduled start of competition for reasons of Force Majeure, the Organisers may retain up to 25% of the Entry fee (as per NCR 11).

ARTICLE 10 INSURANCE

- A) Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia.
Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia National Insurance Program Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au
- B) Service vehicles, management vehicles and reconnaissance vehicles, including those bearing special plates issued by the Organisers, are not to be considered as official participants of the rally. They are therefore not covered by the insurance policy of the rally and will remain the sole responsibility of their owner.

ARTICLE 11 RUNNING OF THE RALLY

- A) A Ballot shall be conducted on Friday evening at the Wheels on Mary Street Party and Saturday evening in the Service Park (as detailed in the event schedule) amongst the first three (3) crews on the published Entry List to determine their start positions for Heats 1 and 2. The Start order for the remainder of the field will be as per the published Start List.
- B) The event will start from TC 0 located in the Rally Village within the Gympie Showgrounds, at 08:30hrs on 5th July 2025
- C) Crew and vehicle are required to present to the Technical Zone 10 minutes prior to their due time from TC 0 as shown on the Leg 1 Start list. The Technical Zone will be located near the entry to TC 0. This area is not a Parc Fermé and RallySafe checks may be carried out by RallySafe personnel.
- D) The starting system for the special stages will be in accordance with the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- E) The official time for the event shall be set to Australian Eastern Standard Time.
- F) Competition in a Heat will only be available to an automobile:
 - Having finished the previous Heat; or
 - Having started, but not necessarily finished, the previous Heat and being placed in the overnight Parc Fermé, as detailed in the event itinerary.
- G) Any crew wishing to re-join in the next Heat must advise the Competitor Relations Officer of the intention to restart no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled publication of the start list for the next Heat.

ARTICLE 12 SCRUTINEERING

- A) Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutineering in accordance with the requirements of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Scrutineering, apparel checks, turbo sealing and automobile weighing for all automobiles will be held on Friday 4th July 2025 between 09:00hrs and 16:00hrs. A member of the service crew may present the automobile and apparel for inspection. The scrutineering location and schedule will be advised by Bulletin.
- C) All signage required by the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations or Bulletin must be in place for scrutineering, at which time, scrutineers will check the signage placement.
- D) Post event scrutineering will be held at a location to be advised in a Bulletin. Information regarding post event scrutineering, e.g. route to travel, will be advised by communication to affected teams.

Qld State competitors

- E) Prior to starting the event, each automobile must undergo scrutiny in accordance with the requirements of the 2025 QLD Rally Championship and Series - Sporting Regulations.
- F) Pre-Event Scrutiny will be available at a venue to be advised. If unable to attend Scrutiny, you may apply to the Chief Scrutineer to have regional Scrutiny. Scrutiny will also be available at the Service Park on Friday 4th July 2025 (refer Item 12B).
- G) Automobile Signage – Queensland competitors must refer to the 2025 Queensland Rally Championship and Series – Sporting Regulations.

ARTICLE 13 TESTING

- A) Testing will be held in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Rally Testing Standing Regulations.
- B) Testing will be available to ALL crews on Thursday 3rd July 2025 from 08:00hrs until 12:00hrs.
- C) Reconnaissance of the Test roads will be available 30 minutes prior to the Testing start times.
- D) Testing costs are \$500 per car. Full details of the testing locations will be emailed direct to the crews, on payment of this fee.
- E) Applications for test sessions can be made using the online application form only. No hard copy forms will be available.

ARTICLE 14 RECONNAISSANCE

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) Reconnaissance will be available on Thursday 3rd July between 12:00hrs and 17:00hrs, and recommence on Friday 4th July between 06:30hrs and 15:00hrs
- C) Reconnaissance will be monitored by the RallySafe Lite (RSLITE) app, including speed and number of passes through stages.
- D) The use of the RSLITE app is **MANDATORY** for all crews doing reconnaissance. Crews are reminded to have the latest version of RSLITE loaded to their phone.
- E) The RSLite App must be switched on during reconnaissance. Any crew found on a Special Stage without the RSLite App switched on and operating, will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation for a penalty to be applied up to disqualification.
- F) A reconnaissance schedule is shown at Attachment 2.

ARTICLE 15 SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.
- B) The Service Park is situated within the Gympie Showgrounds and utilises bitumen roads surrounded by solid (grassed) ground.
- C) There is 240v power and town water available from a small number of power outlets and taps located within the Rally Village area. Power extension cords used are to display a current test certificate.
- D) There will be a Refuel Zone located within the Service Park. All refuelling and/or decanting of fuels is to take place inside this Zone. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- E) There will be two Remote Refuelling Zones on Saturday 5th July 2025. This location will be advised by Bulletin.
- F) The entire Service Park is a designated “Non-smoking” area (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”). Any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Flexi-Service

Refer 2025-2027 Australian Rally Championship Sporting & Technical Regulations (Version 1.3 – Article 20.5).

ARTICLE 16 APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS – CONTROLS AND PARC FERMÉ

- A) For consistency, the penalties and other sporting regulations in the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations shall apply to all crews entered in the Accent Benchtops Rally Queensland (ARC). The 2025 Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championships and Series Sporting Regulations will apply to the results for those entered in the 2025 KickAss Products Motorsport Australia Queensland Rally Championship (QRC) and any other associated events.
- B) Power Stage Media Activities – At the Power Stage Stop Point crews may be required to participate in media activities that will require the crew to remain in the Stop Point control area or close to it. The time that crews remain in this area will be deemed a neutralisation period. The crew will have a Stop Point official note the time of the neutralisation period on their Time Card, this time will be added to the Target Time for that Road Section.

ARTICLE 17 EMERGENCY PROCEDURES AND RED FLAGS

Crews must make themselves familiar with these emergency procedures, as outlined in the Supplementary Regulations and in front of the road book. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty.

A) Emergency Procedure

- I. In the case of an accident where urgent medical or fire attention is required, where possible the red “SOS” sign should be immediately displayed to the following cars and to any helicopter attempting to assist. The Crew, if possible, where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe)
- II. should press the “SOS” button, if available. The system will ask “Medical” or “Fire”? The Crew must press one of the buttons to confirm the situation which will advise Rally Command so the correct emergency service can be dispatched. This can be done at any time following an accident, even if the “OK” message has been activated. If possible, the Crew should call the Rally Command emergency number and advise of their status.
- III. Any crew which has, the RallySafe red SOS screen displayed, the red “SOS” sign displayed to them, or which sees a car which has sustained an accident but is not displaying the green “OK” sign shall immediately and without exception stop to render assistance.
 - a. All following cars shall also stop.
 - b. The first car on the scene shall remain to render assistance.
 - c. The second car at the scene, if necessary, shall proceed to inform the next SOS radio point.
 - d. Notwithstanding the above, any person with appropriate training should remain on the scene if the situation demands
 - e. Subsequent cars shall leave a clear route for emergency vehicles and proceed at a reduced speed, to a maximum of 60kp/h, until the end of the special stage, and follow the instructions of any marshals or intervention car drivers.
 - f. Crews affected by this procedure will be allocated a time according to Article 22 of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations
- IV. In the event of a car stopping on the stage or an accident where immediate medical or fire intervention is not required, the “OK” sign must be clearly and actively shown by a Crew member to at least the three following vehicles and to any helicopter attempting at assist. Where an electronic tracking/warning system is in use (e.g. RallySafe) the Crew **MUST** press the “OK” button within 1 minute of the vehicle stopping, for any reason. Failure to adhere to these requirements will be reported to the Stewards for consideration of disqualification or other penalty

B) Red Flag

In the event of a special stage needing to be stopped, for any reason, SOS point officials will wave a red flag and the screen of the RallySafe console will turn red and show the message “RED FLAG”. On seeing any of these indications the crew **MUST**:

- I. reduce speed to a maximum of 60 km/h for the remainder of the special stage; and
- II. Crews must immediately confirm receipt of the electronic red flag by pressing the “ACKNOWLEDGE” button.

Failure to comply with this rule will entail a penalty at the discretion of the Stewards.

C) Interruption of a Special Stage (including Super Special Stages) – Notional Time

When a special stage is interrupted or stopped for any reason, the Clerk of the Course will allocate, to each affected crew, a time which is judged to be reasonable and fair. A corresponding notification will be published by the Clerk of the Course, however, no crew which is solely or jointly responsible for stopping a stage may benefit from this measure. RSR-Special Stage Rally Articles 5.4 (e), (f) and (g) re Piggyback events do not apply to this event, as ARC and State crews may cross enter in the various competitions.

ARTICLE 18 RESULTS AND PROTESTS

- A) Provisional results will be published on Sportity. These provisional results will become final 30 minutes after publication, subject to no protests being received, no issues are raised out of post event scrutineering and have been approved by the Stewards.
- B) Protests must be lodged in accordance with the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules.
- C) **Rally Regularity:** The 2025-Motorsport Australia Rally-Regularity-Standing-Regulation <https://motorsport.org.au/?pdfs=rally-regularity-standing-regulation>
Rally Regularity: Refer to Item 5 (Sporting Requirements) of the Rally Regularity Standing Regulations
- The Rally Regularity Event will be route charted. Pace or Safety noting and any reconnaissance is not permitted. A maximum terminal speed of 80km/h may be applied and monitored via RallySafe Lite.
 - Awards will be provided to the crew who has received the least amount of penalties.
- D) The events listed in Article 5D, E & F will be scored and results issued by <https://rallyresults.au/>.

ARTICLE 19 AWARDS

- A) As per the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.

 - 1st Manufacturer
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd ARC 2WD Cup, Outright *Driver/Co-driver*

 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd 4WD Classic Cup, Outright *Driver/Co-driver*
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd 2WD Classic Cup, Outright *Driver/Co-driver*
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Junior Cup, Outright *Driver/Co-driver*
 - 1st, 2nd & 3rd Subaru WRX Challenge, Outright *Driver/Co-driver*

The organisers reserve the right to combine trophies where crews win more than one award and add to the awards up to the start of the rally.

ARTICLE 20 ALCOHOL, DRUGS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

- A) Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at motorsport.org.au.

- B) Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
- C) **Consumption of alcohol in the Service Park or any section of the competition venue under the control of rally officials is forbidden until ALL competition is concluded each day.**

ARTICLE 21 EVENT SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Gympie Showgrounds & Service Park

As part of the Event's Agreement to use the Gympie Showgrounds, there is a stipulation that **NO VEHICLES** are permitted to cross the horse training track surrounding the Service Park at any point between 2am and 9am on the mornings of Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th July, and between 2am and 8:00am on Saturday 5 July.

Pedestrian access will be available only via a controlled pedestrian crossing between the Service Park and the Car Park area from **6am to 9am** on Thursday and Friday, and from **6am and 8:00am** on Saturday. This is strictly for pedestrian use only.

This means that any vehicles and/or equipment required for Testing prior to 9am on Thursday, 9am on Friday (for Recce and Scrutiny) and prior to 8am on Saturday, are to be placed in the overnight Car Park area outside the training track ring (refer Service Park map – **Appendix 3**).

Please ensure you comply with these requirements as there will be absolutely no exemptions or excuses. Additionally, there is to be no vehicular movements or starting of vehicle engines adjacent to the perimeter fence surrounding the horse training track (i.e. the flagged fencing) between 0400hrs and 0900hrs on Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th July, and between 0400hrs and 0800hrs on Saturday 5th July. The access gates to the Showgrounds perimeter will be closed at 10pm on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. They will re-open at 6am each morning.

There will be a dedicated roving Security Service in operation in the Service Park between 6pm and 6am on Friday 4 July and Saturday 5 July.

“Wheels on Mary” Street Party - Friday 4th July

The Gympie Regional Council are planning a public activity in Mary Street (Gympie's main street) on Friday 4 July.

Competing cars and their crews are to make their way to the Rally Village Regroup Area where they will be directed to a parking space on arrival at the street venue. Departure from the Gympie Showgrounds will begin at 1720hrs via the Exhibition Rd exit gate for arrival into Mary Street from 1730hrs. Travel instructions will be issued by Communiqué.

Competing cars are then required to be on display at the “Wheels on Mary” street party between 1730hrs and 1930hrs. Competing crews are to be in attendance between 1745hrs and 1915hrs.

Crews are reminded of the requirements of Article 25 of the ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations.

- a. When a Rally Show / Ceremonial Start activity is included in the schedule for a round of the Championship the crew must:
 - (i) Attend the activity for the full time as advised in the Supplementary Regulations or Event Bulletin,
 - (ii) Be positioned with, or in the vicinity of, their vehicle unless required for other activities as advised by the ARC Executive or Event Organiser,
 - (iii) Be attired in their driving suits for the duration of the activity,
 - (iv) Any crew who does not meet the requirements of this article may be reported to the Stewards who may impose a penalty.

Following the “Wheels on Mary” Street Party, **ALL crews** are to return their rally cars to the Rally Village and Service Park for overnight parking (refer map – Schedule 3). Security personnel will be in attendance on Friday and Saturday nights from 6pm-6am.

For all competitors, TC 0 is located **adjacent to the Rally Village and Service Park**. Crews are reminded to be at TC 0 10 minutes before their allocated start time. Refueling will be available in the Refuel Zone for all crews on Saturday morning prior to departure from the Service Park.
